Each event features quality artists and craftsmen, music, food concessions and school instructor demonstrations. The events are conducted on the grounds at the Fletcher Farm School for the Arts and Crafts, located south of Ludlow, Vermont on Route 103. The 38th annual summer festival will be held on Saturday, **July 3rd** and our 30th annual late summer festival will be held on Saturday, **August 21st**. As always, there is no admission fee for the public.

In an effort to maintain the high standard of quality crafts at our festivals, only items handcrafted by the exhibitor will be permitted. Please read the terms and conditions. Remember, new designs and a creative booth display will improve your sales.

This year we will continue to offer lodging on the Fletcher Farm Campus for our exhibitors. Each room has two twin beds and a full bath. Rooms will be available for occupancy at 5 PM on Friday and must be vacated by 10 AM on Sunday. Bed linens are provided, but guests must bring their own towels. Room rate is \$50.00 per night.

Terms and Conditions

1. **All new applicants must send photos to be approved by the committee.** Please send 3 photos or jpeg images representative of your latest creations. Your photos will be used for reviewing and jurying, and may also be included in Festival press releases and advertisements. Your acceptance will depend upon your description of the products you have for sale and the number of vendors selling the same or similar items. Please make your descriptions detailed. If you participated in the 2019 festivals, you only need to send new photos if your product has changed or you'd like new representation of your product.
2. Festivals are held RAIN or SHINE. Outside space is approximately 12' x 12'. Electricity is not available. A limited number of inside spaces are available for an additional fee of \$10.00.
3. Exhibitor supplies all necessary equipment.
4. State of Vermont requires all exhibitors to have Vermont Sales and Use Tax numbers. For information contact: VT Department of Taxes, 109 State Street, Montpelier, VT 05609-1401; 802-828-2551 or e-mail: tax.business@vermont.gov There is NO charge when applying for a VT tax number.
5. Booth sharing will be allowed for an additional fee of \$10.00.
6. Set up time is FRIDAY from 5 PM to 7 PM, and SATURDAY from 7 AM to 9:30 AM. PLEASE NO EARLY ARRIVALS on FRIDAY. Security is NOT provided Friday night.
7. Festival hours are 10 AM to 4 PM. Please maintain the scheduled hours. If you must leave for some unforeseen reason, please contact the Art and Craft Festival Director.
8. Exhibitor is responsible for cleaning the ground area of the booth of all litter at the close of the show.
9. The payment for booth space rental must be sent with the signed contract.
10. Unless a written notice is given at least 30 days prior to the event, the booth fee is non-refundable.
11. The deadline for the July 3rd Festival is May 1, 2021. The deadline for the August 21st Festival is August 1. Applications received after that date will be processed on SPACE AND MEDIA availability.
12. Notification of your space number and a map will be sent prior to the Festival dates.
13. All vendors are required to follow Vermont Department of Health Guidelines for mask wearing and social distancing.
